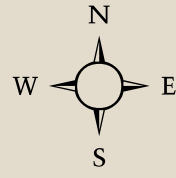


CITY MAP OF WATERTOWN

TERRY REDLIN'S INSPIRATIONAL SITES

- 1 Spring Fever** – The tree house was located on the corner of 9th Avenue North and 2nd Street East in Watertown. Today, only part of the structure remains.
- 2 Family Traditions** – “Olive Place” Walrath home located north on Hwy. 81 at the Junction of Hwy. 81 and County Road 11.
- 3 Autumn Traditions** – The Lakeside Lodge was inspired by Kameska Lodge on Lake Kameska, although not depicted as it appears today, is located on North Lake Drive.
- 4 Prairie Skyline** – Rauville elevator located north on Hwy. 81 to County Road 11 in Rauville, SD.
- 5 Above the Fruited Plain** – Florence elevator on Hwy. 20 in Florence, SD.
- 6 Racing Home** – Old Oviatt house located at 721 - 1st St. NW in Watertown. Mahowald's Harness and Leather (*on the sleigh*) taken from Mahowald's Hardware, 25 N. Broadway St. in uptown Watertown.
- 7 Spring Fishing** – West Kemp Avenue bridge in Riverside Park in Watertown.
- 8 Harvest Moon Ball** – Fortin barn located north on Hwy. 81 to County Road 11, then 6 miles from the Junction of Hwy. 81 and County Road 11 to the old white schoolhouse/church take a left and 1/2 mile down the gravel road is the big white barn with the silo that reads: R.H. Stein (*Terry Redlin's grandfather*) and C. LaFramboise Boys.
- 9 Building The Community** – Larry's Lumber located on North Maple Street
